

Why did Cuba's electricity grid go offline? Cuba's electrical grid went offline Friday after one of the island's major power plants failed, the energy ministry said. What happened to Cuba's power grid after a blackout? Cuba restored a trickle of power to its grid by mid-evening on Friday, officials said, hours after the island plunged into a countrywide blackout following the collapse of one of its major power plants. However the grid collapsed again on Saturday morning, state-run media reported. Did Guerra confirm the collapse of Cuba's electricity grid? Guerra did not directly confirm the total collapse, leaving some confusion as to what exactly had taken place. Cuba's electrical grid first failed around midday on Friday after one of the island's largest power plants shut down, suddenly leaving more than 10 million without power. When will Cuba's power grid be operational again? Cuban officials have not indicated a timeline for when the power grid will be operational again. The massive blackout is a new low in a country that has already been dealing with a deepening economic crisis, compounded by the US embargo and widespread food shortages. How does Cuba get its power? Officials said the state-owned power company UNE was using distributed generation to provide power to some areas of the island and that a gas-fired thermoelectric plant was starting operations. Cuba gets its power from huge thermoelectric plants like Antonio Guiteras and some smaller ones, which require crude oil to operate. What happened to Cuba's power plant? Foul weather had also stalled the arrival of fuel from tanker ships offshore, starving the island's power plants.
