What is the EMS service in Italy? The EMS service in Italy is part of Poste Italiane SpA which is Italy's designated universal postal service provider, supporting customers, businesses and communities worldwide. Poste Italiane SpA was founded in 1993 and joined the EMS Cooperative in 1995. Where can I call emergency medical services in Italy? Since it has also been possible to call by the European emergency number 112, although this is a general police/fire/medical number.
