Imports The top imports of El Salvador are Refined Petroleum (\$1.87B), Petroleum Gas (\$540M), Broadcasting Equipment (\$400M), Packaged Medicaments (\$303M), and Light Rubberized Knitted Fabric (\$300M), importing mostly from United States (\$4.94B), China (\$2.61B), Guatemala (\$2.03B), Mexico (\$1.25B), and Honduras (\$940M). What products does El Salvador export? El Salvador exports mainly manufactured products such as textiles (35 percent of total exports), agricultural products (14 percent) and plastics (9 percent). The country is also a traditional exporter of sugar and coffee. How much money does El Salvador export in ? During the last five reported years the exports of El Salvador have changed by \$1.14B from \$6.33B in to \$7.47B in . The most recent exports are led by Knit T-shirts (\$848M), Knit Sweaters (\$535M), Electrical Capacitors (\$343M), Plastic Lids (\$316M), and Raw Sugar (\$232M). Where did El Salvador ship goods? El Salvador shipped another 3.2% worth of goods to buyers in Europe. Tinier percentages went to customers in Asia (2.3%), Oceania (0.11%) mostly Australia, then Africa (0.07%).
