What are the new road signs in Finland?The Finnish road signs are specified in the Road Traffic Decree. All the road signs are presented on the attached pages. With the new Road Traffic Act, the yellow do not cross line will change to white and several new road signs will appear along roads from 1 June . New road signs include merging lanes and minimum speed. What are mandatory road signs in Finland?Mandatory road signs in Finland are used where you are required to carry out a specific task, they are not suggestions, information or advisory signs, they must be adhered to and as such are arguably the most important roads signs in Finland that you need to know. What are information signs in Finland?Information signs in Finland are the most frequently used road signs in Finland and are generally used on any type of road to provide road users with general information about the road they are using and the road ahead. When did Finland sign a road sign?Finland signed the Vienna Convention on Road Signs and Signals on December 16, and ratified it on April 1, . Whereas European signs usually have white background on warning and prohibition signs, Finnish signs have a yellow/orange colour. How do you know if a road sign is Finnish or Swedish?If the sign includes text, the text is written in Finnish or Swedish, except the stop sign and taxi signs which are written in English (some taxi signs are written in Finnish). Many roads and places in Finland have Finnish and Swedish names, so both are marked on the traffic signs. What are priority road signs in Finland?Priority road signs in Finland are designed to clarify who has priority at the junction / road ahead. If driving in a country where you drive on the other side to the road, priorities are likely to be the opposite of what you are familiar with, roundabouts being a notable difference.
