With the average household in France consuming about kWh electricity (in French) in , the average annual electricity cost in France ranged from EUR - EUR, depending on the electricity provider and plan chosen. This works out to an average monthly power bill of about 108EUR per month. Does France have a pumped storage power station? Pumped Storage: France has a single pumped storage power station - The Grand'Maison Dam capable of absorbing 1.8GW and delivering 2.4GW. Unlike the UK France only records the energy being stored, not delivered. That is included in hydro. In general it is replenished whenever there is surplus power on the grid.
