



## Israel's energy storage exports

The Government of Israel is planning to increase its gas exports; in a recent announcement, the Minister of Energy announced plans to increase gas exports from the Tamar field to Egypt by 60% starting in . Other than supplying Israel's domestic natural gas demand, the export market for natural gas produced in Israel is growing significantly. Total exports of natural gas from Israel increased by 29% compared to . Of the total exports, exports to Egypt grew by 37%, and exports to/via Jordan . In a striking testament to Israel's meteoric rise as a regional energy powerhouse, the country's natural gas exports surged to 13.2 billion cubic meters (BCM) in , up from 11.6 BCM in , according to the latest report from Israel's Natural Gas Authority. This 14% year-over-year increase is a consequence of Israel's energy sector during the Swords of Iron war. Crucially, the success of Israel's natural gas sector is inseparable from its export policy. Without natural gas exports, the development of Israel's gas fields would have stalled, reducing the availability of natural gas for domestic use.
