What services does Kosovo Telecom offer? Kosovo Telecom offers mobile telephone services through its subsidiary Vala and has approximately 50 percent of the market share. Telecommunications infrastructure development, including WiMax and other municipal wireless internet services. Does Kosovo have a mobile phone network? Kosovo Telecom, once the most profitable state-owned enterprise and still the major provider of landline services, is in a crisis state due to political interference, a bloated workforce, inflated wages, and years of mismanagement. The company has come close to bankruptcy, in part due to failure to pay an international arbitration award. What are the consequences of disasters in Kosovo?
