



## Lithium battery pack contacts rust

What should I do if my battery contacts rust? If contacts are heavily rusted or damaged, you may want to use an abrasive such as sandpaper to clean to the base metal. Because many battery contacts are nickel plated, if the corrosion has eaten through this plating the contacts may be susceptible to rusting in the future. How do I fix a rusty battery? Once your wiring is hooked back up to your battery, you can apply White Lithium Grease to all the bare metal parts at the connection points. This will not only take care of your current problem, but prevent future build up or rust. How do you know if a battery terminal is rusty? Spotting corrosion on battery terminals is easy once you know what to look for. It usually shows up as a powdery or gritty buildup around the terminal, often in colors like white, light blue, greenish-gray, or brown. These deposits can look like rust and tend to pile up over time if not cleaned. Does white lithium grease cause electrical problems? The White Lithium Grease will not cause issues with your electrical connection and can be found in your local automotive store. The grease will prevent corrosion by forming a layer between the conducting surfaces, eliminating contact by moisture and air. How do you clean a lithium battery? Dip a cotton swab in the paste and rub the contact points. Wipe clean with a paper towel before inserting new batteries. When no more residue is transferred, carefully dry the contact points with a paper towel. Lithium batteries are used in laptops, cell phones, and vape pens.
