Who manages Myanmar's energy sector? Myanmar's energy sector is managed by the Ministry of Electric Power (MOEP) and the Ministry of Energy (MOE), which together account for over one-third of public sector revenue. Before May, the two ministries operated under one single Ministry of Electricity and Energy (MOEE). How much electricity does Myanmar generate per day? The Maximum Electricity Generation on 2 July is .2 MW and Total Generation Unit is 47500.3MWhr per day.
