Is free Senegal launching 5G in ? Free Senegal also launched an experimental phase of 5G in June . In July , Sonatel, along with its parent company Orange, opened a 5G Lab in the capital, Dakar. In March , ARTP instructed Sonatel and Free to halt their network trials and submit a progress report to the regulator.

Does Senegal have a 4G network? Sonatel the historic public operator of telecommunications in Senegal currently works under the brand, Orange, a French-based company. Orange has launched 4G and 4G+, while Free obtained its 4G License in .
