Vatican officials have estimated it will cost under 100 million euros (\$114 million) to develop the solar farm, and that once it is approved by the Italian parliament, the contracts to do the ROME (AP) -- Italy agreed Thursday to a Vatican plan to turn a 430-hectare (1,000-acre) field north of Rome, once the source of controversy between the two, into a vast solar farm that the Holy See hopes will generate enough electricity to meet its needs and turn Vatican City into the world's first carbon-neutral state.
